### One Year Memberships Valid through September 30, 2026

#### \$90 - Active Member

Hold a master's degree or higher with emphasis in speech-language pathology, audiology, speech or hearing science or education of the hearing impaired; must be a resident of or be employed in Indiana.

#### \$90 - Associate Member

Hold a bachelor's degree with a major emphasis in speech-language pathology, audiology, speech or hearing science or education of the hearing impaired; must be employed in or a resident of Indiana. Any person having held previous active membership who no longer lives or is employed in Indiana may transfer to associate membership.

#### \$90 - SLPA Member

Speech-language pathology assistants holding a license, certification or registration as defined by state requirements.

#### \$25 - Life Member

Any person, upon reaching the age of sixty-five (65) years, or who must retire from professional employment because of health reasons, and who has been an active member in good standing for a total of twenty-five (25) years, may apply for life member status. #### FREE - Clinical Fellow/Recent Grad

Clinical Fellow must be actively completing fellowship or have completed fellowship and awaiting CCCs.

#### FREE - Student

Enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate program with a major emphasis in speech-language pathology, audiology, speech or hearing science or education of the hearing impaired and shall not be gainfully employed in any of the above professions except as a recipient of a scholarship or other educational stipend.

*Emerging Ethical Issues in Our Transforming Workplaces*

Since Covid, many of our workplaces have changed dramatically. Generative AI has exploded in the past few years, creating new and faster ways to perform daily tasks. Professionals are moving around more, searching for a job that fits their lifestyle. Many practitioners are struggling with the additional time, effort and education that may be needed when working with culturally and linguistically diverse populations. Each of these situations creates their own set of ethical issues. During this presentation we will discuss how the ASHA Code of Ethics applies to these - and other - scenarios and answer ethical questions you may have.

Effective clinical supervision and coaching is essential to develop competent speech-language pathologists and to support them as they educate patients and caregivers. Clinicians and leaders should understand their own communication style and learning needs and adapt to support others. This presentation will focus on strategies to provide clinical support and coaching for all learners that they may then apply to clinical care. Tenets from different best practices and current research from our field and related health care areas will be discussed. Special emphasis will be placed on adapting clinical support based on learners' cultural backgrounds and individual needs, including disabilities.
