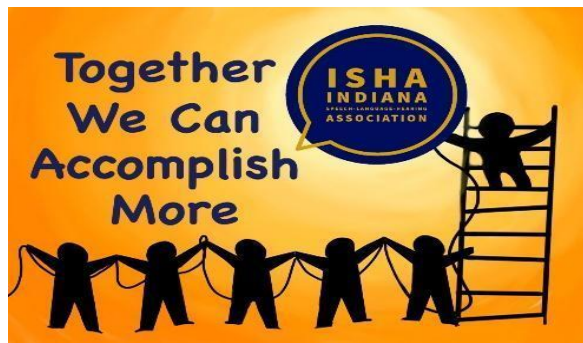




Thank you for scheduling your tour of the Indiana Statehouse. We look forward to seeing you!

Things to know before you arrive

- The maximum number of individuals we can accommodate per tour is 100.
- Please plan to arrive early to allow time for a security check and restroom break.
- All busses are required to drop off passengers on the east side of the Statehouse on Capitol Avenue. Please enter through the east doors.
- For a \$20 cash fee, buses can park at the Indianapolis Zoo (1200 West Washington Street.) Buses are not permitted to park on Capitol Avenue.
- Cars can park at metered spots in the area, or in area garages.
- As you tour, please keep talking and noise at a minimum. There are many offices in the Statehouse, and it is important to be respectful of those individuals who are working.
- No gum, food, or beverages are allowed.
- Please let us know if you plan to bring lunches. We will store them for you while you tour. If you would like to eat your boxed sack lunches at the Government Center Cafeteria, we would be happy to walk you to the cafeteria or Bicentennial Plaza.
- You can purchase boxed lunches from the Government Center Cafeteria by calling (317)233-4354.
- The lower west entrance that faces Senate Avenue is the only ADA entrance.
- Saturday visitors must use the lower west entrance.
- The length of your tour will be determined when you schedule your tour.
- Cameras, including those with flash, are permitted.
- The Indiana Statehouse is a public building. Walk-in tours may join any posted tour.

Directional information within the Capitol:

Students and audiology and speech-language pathology professionals will check in on the north end of the fourth floor. There are two public entrances. The Capitol Ave. entrance leads you directly on to the main floor/second floor. If you use the Senate Ave. door, which is the first floor/basement, people should turn left when they get through security, take another left, and take the elevator to the fourth floor.

We will meet with the legislators on the north end of the third floor.

Once your plans to attend are confirmed:

- ✓ Participate in the Virtual Training Session
- ✓ Complete the Legislative Day RSVP form with your information.
- ✓ Contact the point person for your University or dewetzel@purdue.edu if you have any questions or concerns.
- ✓ Invite your State Senator and Representative to attend the event

It is imperative that you take that extra moment to send a personal invitation to your state legislators. When contacting legislators, contact both State Senator and State Representative but NOT Congressional legislators. Be sure to let them know that you will be attending and look forward to meeting with them. ISHA will send an invitation to all of the state legislators but a personal invitation from a constituent is always more effective in getting legislators to attend. If your legislator cannot attend the luncheon, offer to meet with them virtually another day. The personal invitation and contact are ESSENTIAL!

Finding your legislator

This link <https://iga.in.gov/legislative/find-legislators/> should take you directly there.

Fill in your street address, city, and zip code in the space provided.

The site will identify your legislative district, and state and congressional legislators.

Click on the legislator's name and this will take you to their site where you will find their phone numbers, how to email, and information regarding bills they have sponsored etc.

If the email is not visible, click on "Email Me". The emails should then be listed on the left side of the webpage.

Parking:

Less expensive but not as close parking garages:

Circle Center Mall Indianapolis has 3 parking garages around the location:

World of Wonders Garage: 24-hour access

(Entrances on Illinois and Maryland)

Sun Garage: Mon. - Sat.: 8:00 a.m. - 2:00 a.m., Sun.: 10:00 a.m. - Midnight

(Entrances on Washington and Maryland)

Moon Garage: Mon. - Sat.: 8:00 a.m. - Midnight, Sun.: 10:00 a.m. - 9:00 p.m.

(Entrance on Georgia)

Parking Hours & Rates:
